### A Special Note from Director Dave Ross:

The pandemic continues to impact the ski resorts, our staffing, and operations. As a result, a few features of our bus trips have been reduced or eliminated for the foreseeable future. To comply with changing ski area policies, reduce costs, and ensure our buses can run properly, we initially will offer reduced departure dates and locations, eliminate the hot beverage service, and variable ticket pricing.

As always, safety is our number one priority. It's unclear what CDC guidance will be this season, but for now all riders will be required to be vaccinated. We will also operate at reduced capacity (about 60%) and masks may be required during the trip.
